One only needs to look at *Get it* fashion shoots to see that Sandile is extremely creative. She is also an attentive listener during one-on-one conversations.

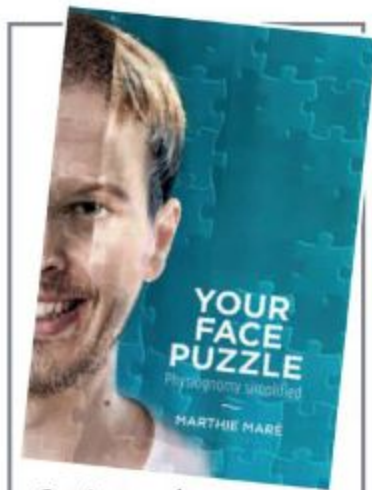


JANINE CRONJÉ, LAYOUT ARTIST
